2 is a conversation between London and Islamabad, through bus journeys. There is no destination - the journey becomes a way to collect everyday choices within the two cities, nested within gestures in the bus. The film came out of a series of conversations and exchanges through Zoom meetings held during the pandemic, using screens as a way to smudge borders and create modes of working together across continents.

During the conversations, questions of ownership began to surface. Both of us came to the cities where we now live, from the outside. In this way, the camera becomes a way to bridge the distance between our personal histories and the history of the cities, whilst also becoming an interface through which we can negotiate ownership over movement in the city, as women. 2 is a collaborative project between Anastasia Alekseeva and Sayera Anwar.
